EVENT CONDITIONS

1. To be held from October 30th to November 3rd 2024 in **Chassieu, at Lyon Eurexpo**
2. For five, six, seven, and eight-year-old horses – Open to all breeds – Entry must be named and nominated into the European Nomination Program at the time of entry. See the current *NRHA Handbook* for information on how the age of a horse is determined.
3. **NRHA MEMBERSHIP:** All competitors must be NRHA members in good standing and hold the appropriate membership for their participation in the event. All owners of horses that are competing must be a current general or youth member in good standing at minimum.
4. Owners may enter more than one horse. Riders may ride no more than three horses per Derby class.
5. **Entry deadline:** October 1st 2024. Entries by online-inscriptions and/or mail shall be binding. Entries and stable reservations will not be handled before receipt of payment.

6. By submitting the entry form rider/horse owner accepts all show conditions and regulations and the 2024 NRHA Rules and Regulation. Rider/horse owner will follow all instructions by the show management. All decisions made by the show management are binding and final.
7. **PARTICIPATION:** Entries will not be considered unless forms are filled completely and received by the organizer in due time, accompanied by horse documentation (AQHA, APHA, etc.) including NRHA Competition License, a copy of the valid NRHA Membership Card (rider and owner), and evidence of payment of all fees. Permission to participate will not be granted unless a valid NRHA Membership Card is provided latest on the 1st day of the event. Rider/horse owner assures that the horse(s) is free of any contagious diseases, properly vaccinated and carries public liability insurance at the time the horse arrives at the show grounds.
8. **PAYMENT OF FEES:** Complete payment information will be included on the entry form. It is the owner's responsibility to make the entry on or before the due date. Show Management will not be responsible for entries not received by the due date or lost in the mail. Failure to pay applies to the rider, owner, or agent for any unpaid debts, related to the entry, exhibition, showing, stalling, or any related fee of an entry at an approved NRHA event. Agent is defined as anyone who acts and/or signs on the behalf of an owner or rider (see General Rules and Regulations, F. Failure to pay in the current *NRHA Handbook*).
9. Horses may be entered into both the open and non pro division, but we suggest entering at the time of the entry deadline to assist with scheduling.
Horses competing in the Non Pro Derby who DO NOT MAKE THE FINALS will have 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last Non Pro horse's run to enter the Open division with a 20% late fee (see "late fee" in the Non Pro derby conditions below).

All other entries after the entry deadline will be considered according to the timetable and have to be done before 18 h the day before the class. ANY FURTHER LATE REGISTRATIONS AT THE SHOW WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IF THE NUMBER OF RIDERS EXCEEDS THE TIMETABLE FOR THE SCHEDULE OF THE DAY. You can confirm the day before the competition.
10. **SUBSTITUTION/TRANSFERS BETWEEN DERBIES:** Substitutions of horses/entries will be permitted after entry deadline but must be completed before 5pm two days prior to the first go-round, a penalty of 20% of the entry fee will apply (see late fee in the conditions below). Late entries at the show may or may not be accepted dependent upon the scheduled time allotted. An entry may transfer from the Open to Non Pro Derby after entry deadline but must be completed before 5pm two days prior to the first go-round. That entry will then be placed in a group to precede the regular draw in the reverse order that they were received. The Open Derby entry fee will be refund ; the Non Pro Derby entry fee with a penalty of 20% must be paid. All entry payments will be applied to Non Pro Derby entry fees. An entry may transfer from the Non Pro to Open Derby after entry deadline but must be completed before 5pm two days prior to the first go-round. That entry will then be placed in a group to precede the regular draw in the reverse order that they were received. The Non Pro Derby entry fee will be refunded; the Open Derby entry fee with a penalty of 20% must be paid. All entry payments will be applied to Open Derby entry fees.
11. **SCRATCHES:** The show secretary must be notified if an entry will be scratched. If the scratched entry has a balance due, that amount must still be paid.
12. **REFUNDS:** 50% of the entry fees paid will be refunded for horses entered and scratched for medical reasons only. Supporting letters of a veterinarian must accompany the scratch notices. Scratch notices

received without veterinarian statements will not receive any refunds. Office Fee will not be refunded. When the official draw is posted Rider/Owner will not receive any refunds.

13. **SHOW RETAINAGE:** The Show retainage for the Derby will be 50%, in addition to the standard 5% NRHA show fee deduction.
14. **CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP:** An entered horse may change ownership and retain entry status under the new owner provided that the transfer of the NRHA Competition License is complete and the new owner is a member of the National Reining Horse Association. Changes may not be made during the go-round and between go-rounds and final.
15. **PAYEE:** Prize money will be paid to the owner as recorded in the NRHA database at the start of the event or designated agent. The prize money will be paid by bank transfer to the bank account of the Recipient of Payback, as filled in the entry form. Recipient of Invoice is responsible to provide the correct information for bank transfer. Taxes may be deducted as national laws dictate. If the horse is transferred during the show, the previous owner and the new owner must complete an Authorization of Prize Money Payment Form.
16. **CONVERSION RATE:** The Euro- US Dollar exchange rate for payback calculation is 1,10 (2024 NRHA Currency Exchange)
17. **RIDERS:** Rider for horses entered in the Open Derby must be designated no later than entry deadline. If the Rider Designation is not received by entry deadline, the rider will be indicated as "Rider Not Designated" and NRHA is not responsible for draw positions closer than the conditions specify. In the Open draw, NRHA will attempt to separate horses with a common rider by at least fifteen (15) horses or highest number possible. In the Non Pro draw, NRHA will attempt to separate horses with a common rider or owner by at least twenty (20) horses or highest number possible.
18. **JUDGES:** There will be five (5) judges placed at different points in the arena for the Derby; the high score and low score will be eliminated with only the total of the remaining three (3) scores used to determine the final score. A pre-check will be utilized. A judge's monitor will be present for the duration of the Euroderby classes.
19. **JUDGES FEES:** The Judges fee is due at the time entry is made.
20. **CONDITION CHANGES:** These rules and conditions are subject to change by action of the European Executive Board, European Council or the NRHA Board of Directors. The NRHA Board of Directors reserves the right to interpret, modify or amend conditions for the NRHA European Derby. If requiring immediate attention, those rights will be deferred to the European Executive Board.
21. **RIGHT TO CANCEL:** Entries are received subject to the right of NRHA European Council to refuse the entry, or a transfer of the entry, without notice to the subscriber. Acceptance of the entry is based on the representations made on the entry form. Decisions of the Executive Committee will be final. Riders are responsible to know and adhere to eligibility requirements for NRHA events. A rider who enters an event or division in which he/she is ineligible, will forfeit all winnings and entry fees to the NRHA, and be subjected to disciplinary action by the NRHA Board of Directors for unsportsmanlike conduct as set forth in the current NRHA Handbook. The rider is responsible for the entry information regardless of whether the form is completed by the agent or owner. The Show Management reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the contest without liability, but in such event will return all entry money to the payee. Interest earned on all fees is the property of Show Management.

22. Show management reserves the right to discipline any person that it concludes has abused or permitted abusive behavior against a horse, or engaged in unsportsmanlike conduct toward show management, judges, or exhibitors. Discipline may include official warning, elimination from competition or any other action deemed appropriate by the Show Management.
23. The restricted European eligibility will apply for the Derby classes.
24. **TIES:** In the event of a tie in a final, the tie-breaking procedures as outlined in the current year *NRHA Handbook* will be used to break the tie.
25. **RIBBON PRESENTATION:** Prize money will be paid only if the rider shows up at the ribbons presentation as required by the show management.
26. **ANIMAL WELFARE AND MEDICATIONS TESTING** All horses entered in the NRHA European Derby are subject to examination. Please refer to the NRHA European Region Animal Welfare and Medications policy for details on the Animal Welfare and Medications Rule. It is not NRHA's intention to conflict with rules and regulations of states, provinces, or countries in regard to medications. **In cases, where NRHA shows are held in states, provinces or countries with medications rules and regulations, the rules and regulations of the state, province or country take precedence.**

28. FINAL SECTIONS DRAW LISTS

All Level 4 Finalists and all Horses entered exclusively in TRFAM Qualifier will be in Section 2 reserved for the TRFAM only. Anyone who did not make the Level 4 Finals and entered in the TRFAM Qualifier will go in Section 2 reserved for the TRFAM only. Riders with three horses qualified for Section Level 4, can choose to put TRFAM only horses in Section reserved for the TRFAM only .

After the finalists have been decided for Section 1 and 2, the draw lists will be selected by lot during a draw party. Derby horses draw first, and horses entered in TRFAM only draw the remaining spots.

29 Payout Open Level 1,2,3 & 4 / Non Pro Level 1,2,3 & 4

The entire payout purse will be used for the finals. Every finalist will get a guaranteed base payout for the Level he/she made it back in plus a percentage from the left-over purse for that Level following the schedules below.
